

## ADJUSTABLE, MULTI-USE, UTILITY FORKS

FOR USE WITH THE STYLE 2001AP OR 2001SP CHESTS

The all-new redesigned multi-use utility forks provide holding solutions for cleaning and servicing activities. Originally designed for firearm cleaning and service the Gerstner multi-use forks can be used for many other activities requiring that handy third hand to hold and position items being serviced. The multi-use forks however should never be used as a bench rest tool for shooting live rounds. Recoil from any firearm could permanently damage the chest and cause personal injury or death. Always practice safe firearm handling and never service loaded firearms or magazines. Keep live rounds or loaded magazines separate and away from not shooting activities.

## TYPICAL LONG GUN SET-UP

- · Remove the parts tray from top of chest.
- Slide forks over the sides of chest as shown.
- Turn the wing nuts until snug, do not over tighten.
- Set-up is complete and the multi-use forks are ready to use.









## **AUTO LOADING PISTOL SET-UP**

Forks will not work with revolver style pistols.

- Remove the parts tray from top of chest.
- · Each of the fork arms are different thicknesses. With the pistol unloaded and magazine (clip) removed find the arm that will best fit inside the magazine well.
- Slide the proper fork over the middle partition of chest as shown.
- Turn the wing nuts until snug, do not over tighten
- Install the pistol onto the fork arm for service.









## AR-15 TACTICAL SUPPORT SETUP

16" carbine length or less

- Remove the parts tray from the top of the chest.
- Locate and install the fork with the barrel hole in the middle. Install this on your preferred side of the chest.
- Install the mag well support on the opposite side of the chest.
- Turn the wing nuts until snug, do not over tighten
- · Chest is ready to use. Note: for pistol length or SBR uppers it may be necessary to position the mag well support closer to the barrel support.
